Calling all flight schools and college aviation programs! Here is a rare opportunity to own a **Redbird MCX Flight Simulator** to greatly enhance and elevate your flight curriculums.

The MCX is one of the most advanced flight simulators on the market and is equipped with a 3-axis electric motion platform giving the trainee a one-of-a-kind simulated training experience with realistic feedback for yaw, pitch, and roll. It gives a lifelike feel of the controls and provides believable simulated flight scenarios from its high resolution six-screen cockpit view array.



This used simulator with 3467.7 total training hours can be configured as a realistic piston single or twin aircraft. It includes the panel and throttle configurations for four popular training aircraft models: a Piper PA-28-181 Archer with a conventional (steamgauge) instrument panel; a Cessna CE-172 Skyhawk with conventional instrument panel, a Cessna CE-182-RG Skylane with the Garmin G1000-glass cockpit instrument panel, and a twin engine Piper PA-44 Seminole with a conventional instrument panel with

multiengine throttle quadrant. The simulator has dual yoke and dual rudder controls allowing for in-simulation dual flight instruction as well as simulation-based CRM training.

With the purchase of additional simulation equipment and upgrades from Redbird, this MCX can be modified to simulate other popular training aircraft, including a Piper Warrior or Seneca, and the Beechcraft Bonanza or the Baron or Duchess, and others.

The simulator is fully self-contained in a sturdy cabin and is built on a strong, balanced metal chassis. It is robust enough to stand-up to years of use in a large professional pilot academy. The system can be operated in small spaces of at least 16' x 16' with a ceiling that is at least 8' high. It uses the standard 110-volt, 15-amp wall outlet and requires a high-speed Internet connection. The MCX produces simulated flight sounds but has a low mechanical noise and will not disrupt your co-located business or academic functions. The

The MCX Flight Simulator is an FAA Approved Full Motion AATD capable of supporting the following Pilot Licenses and Ratings: Private, Instrument, and Airline Transport Pilot. It can be used to support currency, proficiency, and insurance checks.

The simulator unit is presently located in Heston, Kansas. Relocation and set-up services are available from Redbird but are not included in the selling price.

The seller purchased this simulator brand new from Redbird and has added the accessory panels over the years. The total cost paid for the simulator and accessories was \$110,300.00. But this upgraded MCX can be yours today for just \$68,000.
