

Rare, very low time Cessna Cardinal 177RG for the lowest price.

Only 1948 hours total time. Recent extensive annual and then flown across multiple states. Flies well. The previous owner had it hangared in the Midwest. It wasn't flown for a number of years but it still started right up. When we bought it we flew it over 600 miles and did an extensive annual with many new parts.

Extensive annual - New alternator, tires, ADS-B, windshield, JPI 830 digital engine monitor (which is really useful to monitor the engine and fuel). Full spar AD complied with and signed off.

Clean interior, the front seats center inserts are a little worn out. Paint in some sections has cracking and peeling.

Cardinals are the easiest entry access single engine with the largest interior space in its class. Smooth predictable controls. One of the best planes to fly around 130-140 knots, at only 10GPH with over 600 mile range.

Clean history. Both airplane and engine have 1948 hours. Lycoming IO-360 200HP fuel injected engine is regarded as one of the most reliable. Engine compressions 78 / 76 / 76 / 78. The last 177RG I owned had over 2600 hours on the engine and it was still running well.
