BASICS: Factory Metal Spar; Dual Toe Brakes; Garmin GTN375; ADs-B in/out; Garmin GTR200, New Flightline Ultraleather Interior; Wide Rear Seat; Hooker Harness with inertial reels; Rudder Pedal Extensions (can easily be uninstalled).

KNOWN HISTORY - Two owners ago, I was told the plane was used to haul big game meat and antlers for hunters in Arizona. The previous owner moved the plane in September 2022 to his hangar at the Lansing Municipal Airport (KIGQ) in Indiana and completely restored the plane interior planning to make it their forever plane. But as we all know, nothing is really forever. It was replaced by a Vultee BT-13A.

RECENT USE - I sold my 1966 Cessna 172 Skyhawk and purchased the Citabria in the late fall of 2024 and had it ferried to my hangar at the Turners Falls Airport (0B5). I purchased the plane to increase my tailwheel time and proficiency. In 2025 my instruction and solo PIC time was 100+ hours. I love flying the plane, but I am now finishing a Bearhawk 5 in the build assist program and it is time to let it go. However, the plane will be flying until sold, so times will change.
